



Financial Statements Analysis

This course is an introduction to understanding how to use financial information to value and analyse companies.

The course focuses on the practical application of financial statements analysis. Participants will learn how to create and analyse financial ratios, such as debt to equity, profit margins and more. Participants will gain analytical skills involved in reading and interpreting the financial health and profitability of a company through quantitative and qualitative techniques. A number of case studies and financial statements of actual companies will be analysed.

Sample Topics Covered:

Understanding financial statements using samples from published local companies' reports including:

- Default accounting framework in Malta;
- Detailed analysis of important statements like the Income Statement, Balance Sheet and the Cash Flow Statement;
- Explanation of material line items disclosed;
- Other relevant information disclosed like the Directors' Report and the Auditor's Report.

Financial ratio analysis:

- Profitability ratios;
 - Management efficiency ratios;
 - Liquidity ratios;
 - Gearing ratios;
 - Investors ratios.
