About the Job

It is one of the leading organisations within Malta's Financial Services sector.

The Independent Internal Auditor will report to the Exchange's Audit Committee.

Responsibilities

- Assist in the development and execution of an internal audit plan
- Evaluate the effectiveness of governance, risk management and control processes, suggesting improvements to current practices
- Carry out an independent review and appraisal of control systems across the organisation (both financial control systems and operational areas) against best practices
- Ascertain the extent of compliance of policies, procedures, regulations and legislation
- Facilitate good practices in management of risks
- Identify waste, inefficiency and duplication of efforts across the organisation
- Structure programs and activities such that company assets are safeguarded and there are internal systems in place which minimize the possibility of fraud
- Report periodically to the Audit Committee and the Board of Directors

Working Conditions

Applicants must: -

- Be in possession of an honour's degree or equivalent qualification in accountancy, with a warrant and must hold a Practicing Certificate in Auditing
- Be a Certified Information Systems Auditor (CISA) or in the possession of an equivalent certification in IS auditing
- Have previous experience in providing similar services
- Have more than five years' experience in the audits (external and/ or internal) of regulated entities
- Possession of the Institute of Internal Auditors (IIA) certification will be considered an asset.
